Install a Water Saving Shower head. Short Showers! - 4 min

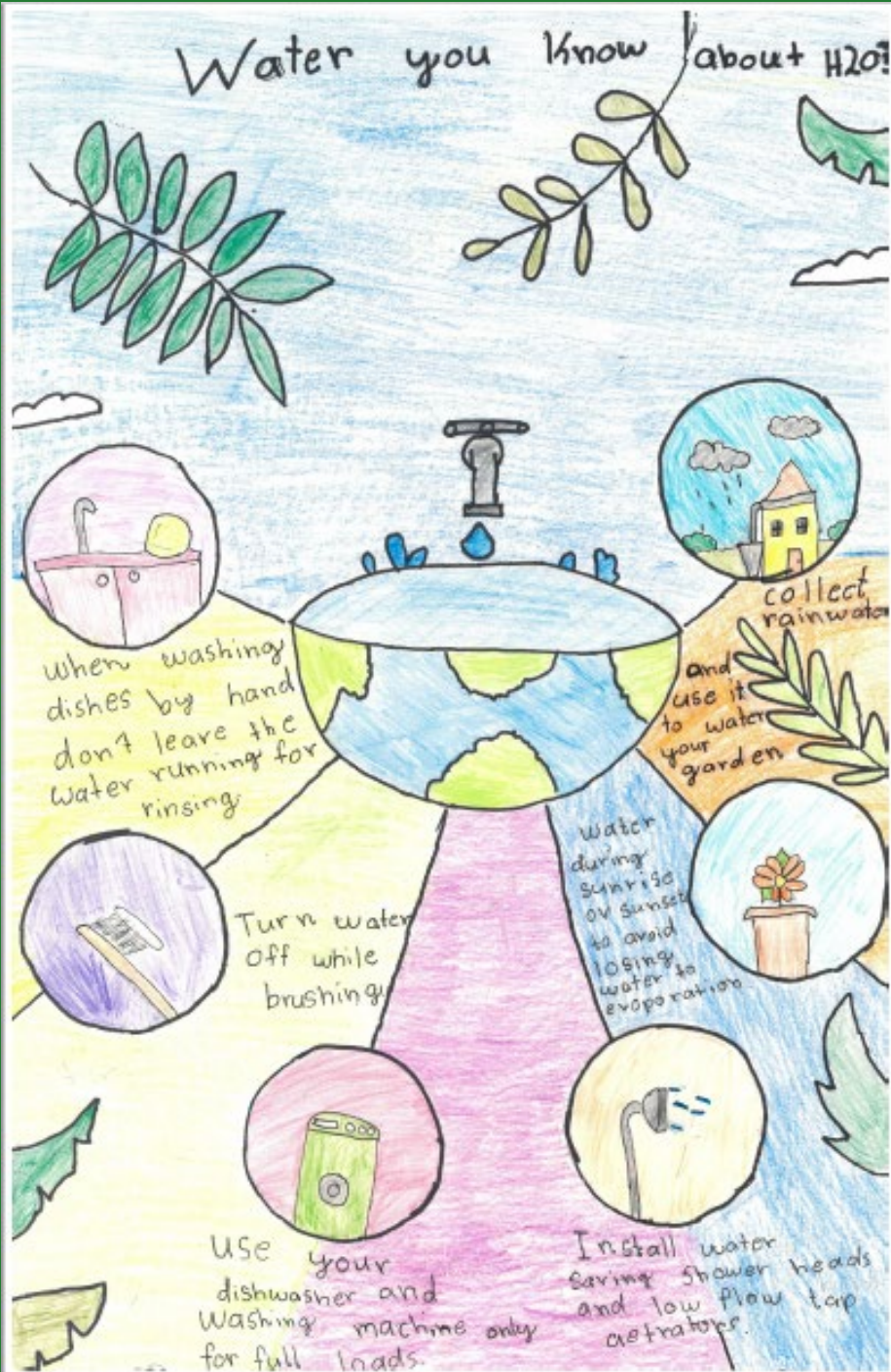

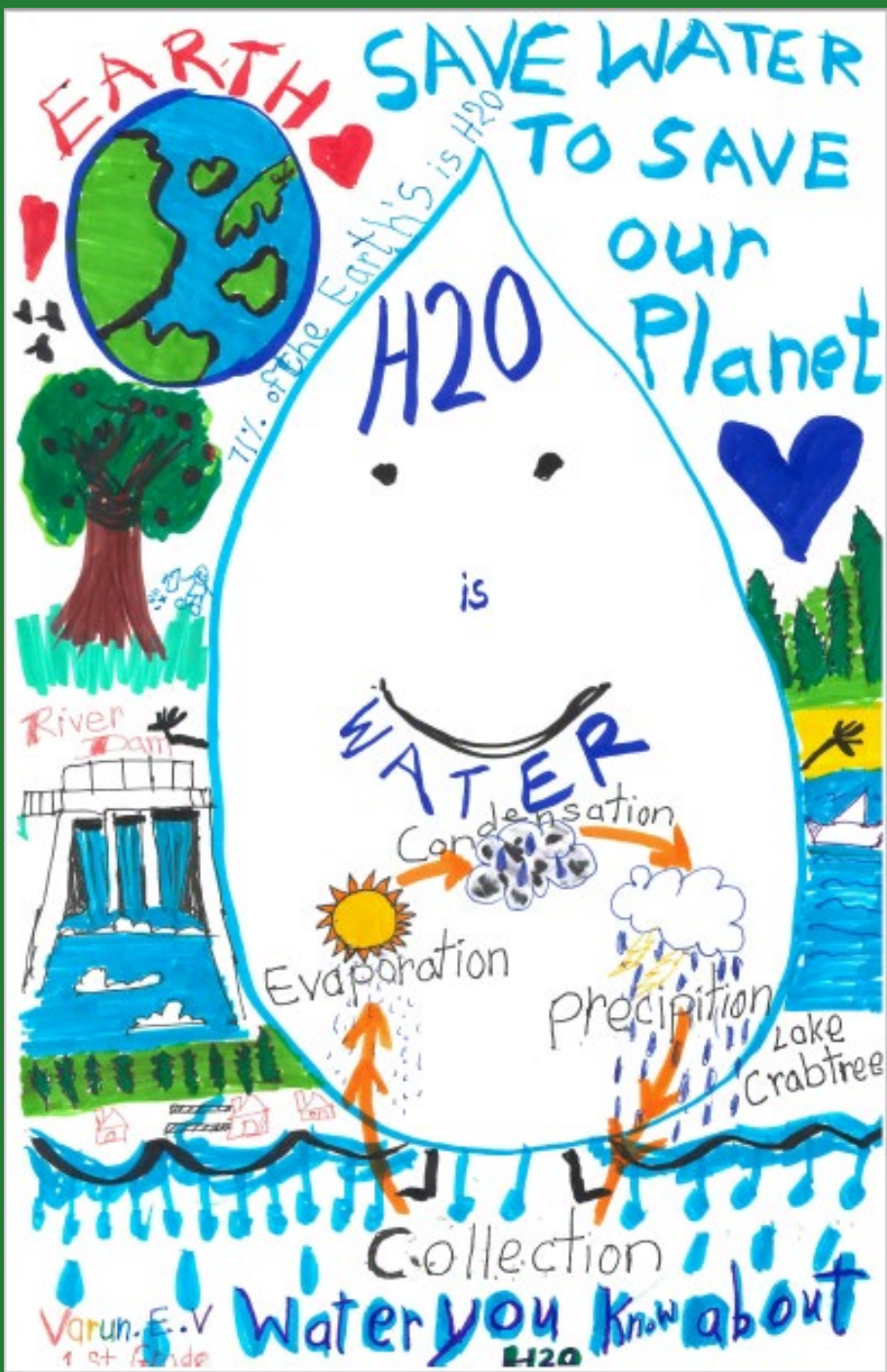

Reuse waste waters from showers, sinks & laundry for irrigation, cooling, toilets

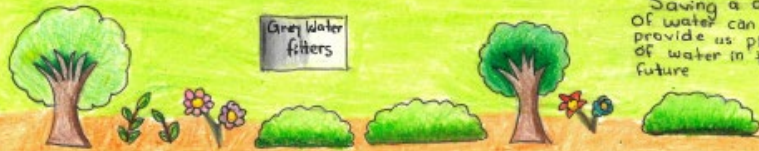

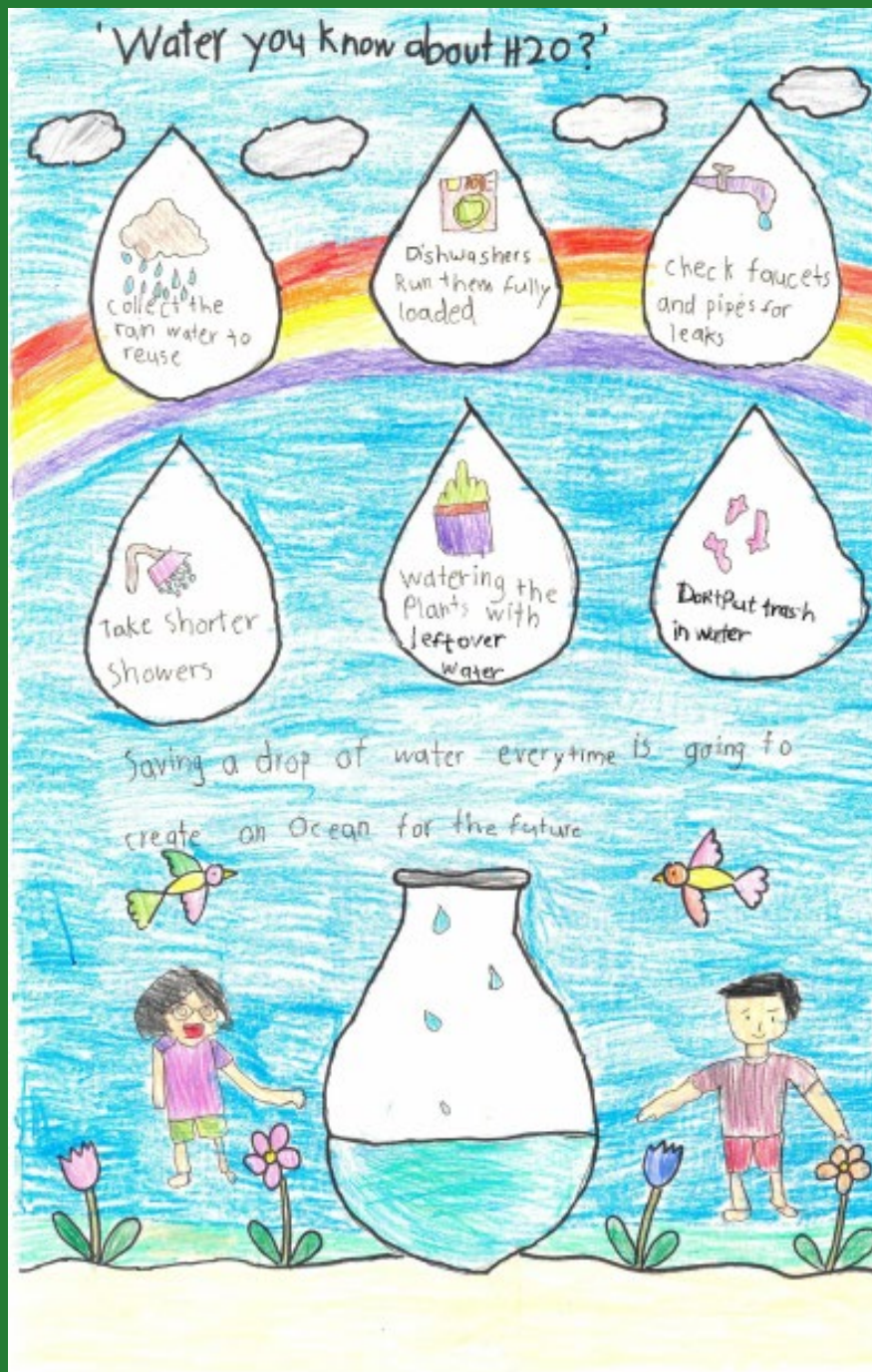

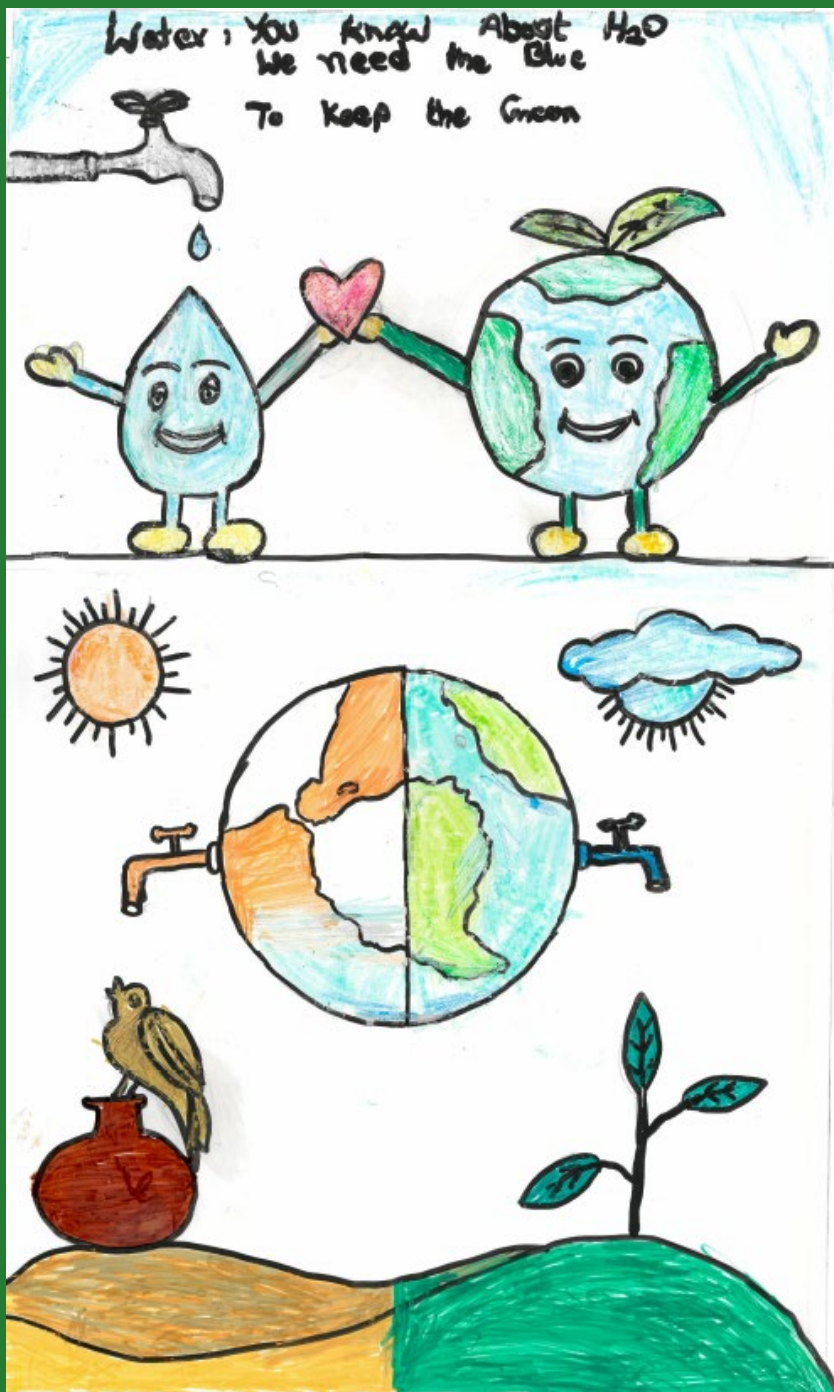
